SUMMER WATER AEROBICS SCHEDULE 2010

For ease of planning for both participants and instructors, the following water aerobics are scheduled for this summer.

MORNING CLASSES:

We will be running two separate sessions of classes in the morning. Morning sessions will be held every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m., and are four weeks long (a total of 12 one-hour classes).

The cost for morning session classes is \$30 per session for members and \$50 per session for non-members.

First session of morning classes begins June 8th and ends July 1st, 2010. Sign up and prepay no later than June 1, 2010 for this session.

Second session of classes begins July 13th and ends August 5th, 2010. Sign up and prepay by July 6, 2010 for this class.

EVENING CLASS:

There will be ONLY one session of evening classes, which will be held four nights per week for a two week period in August (a total of 8 one-hour classes).

Evening classes will be held Monday through Thursday evenings from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

The cost for the evening session of classes is \$20 for members and \$35 for non-members.

The evening session begins on August 9th and ends August 19th, 2010. Sign up and prepay by August 2, 2010 for this class.

At least eight (paid) participants are required to hold a class.

(You may bring a friend or drop-in on a casual one-time basis for \$5 per session on any of the regularly scheduled classes. Drop-ins or one-time participants do not count toward the minimum requirement of 8 people to schedule a class, though. Once scheduled, classes will be held if there are fewer than 8 people in attendance, we just need at least 8 people to pay to cover the cost of the instructor.)

TRAIL RIDES

At Dutch Hollow Lake

We are pleased to announce that weekend horseback rides on Dutch Hollow Lake trails will again be offered this summer.

The ride will take approximately 2 1/2 hours to complete.

For your convenience, and the convenience of the service provider, rides are scheduled by appointment only.

Simply call at least 24 hours in advance to make your reservation.

Rides will not be scheduled for less than two riders, or more than four riders on a single ride. Riders must be 16 or older.

\$50 per rider for 2 1/2 hour ride.

All rides begin at the upper level clubhouse parking lot, above the beach.

Rules:

1. Each participant is required to bring his/her own fishing equipment including a bucket to hold their catch. To ensure fish health, organizers will canvas the area to make sure all are in compliance.
2. Any child of an owner or guest 12 years of age and under can participate.
3. Kids under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
4. There are no restrictions on the type of bait used.
5. The amount of help given by an accompanying adult is limited. The adults can only help with setting up the fishing equipment i.e. tying of a hook on a fishing line.
6. The participants will be fishing from the shore in the immediate clubhouse area. **NO FISHING ON THE BEACH!**

Each registered participant will receive a ticket for a “free” lunch. Additional lunches for non-participants can be purchased for \$2.

Long Term Rentals and Transfer of Membership Rights

Short-term rentals of homes at Dutch Hollow Lake are prohibited. Short-term rentals are defined as any rental agreement verbal or written lasting less than 6 months in duration.

In addition, if you rent your home on a long-term basis (6 months or more), you are required to file a copy of your rental agreement with the Association office.

You may “transfer” your rights to the amenities at Dutch Hollow Lake to a long term renter. However, if you give those rights to your renter, you give up your use rights at the same time. For example, the renter may purchase a season pool pass for the “member” rate, and have all the same rights of use as a member during their rental period, if you authorize it. However, you lose the right then to purchase a member pass for that property.

There is one exception, however, voting rights cannot be transferred. The owner of the property is the only one authorized to vote.

A simple form is available at the Association office to transfer your rights to a renter, if it is not specified in your rental agreement.

Your rights can only be transferred to a renter. Other friends and relatives will generally be covered under guest use rules.

Guest Passes

If you authorize guests to use Dutch Hollow Lake and amenities when you are not present, you must notify the Association office in advance of the name of the guest(s), and the date they will be here.

Guests are placed on an “authorized guest” list, for ease of use. The gate guard can get them through quickly, their passes are made up in advance, and nobody gets embarrassed.

This policy is for member’s protection and helps tremendously to prevent unauthorized use (and misuse) of your facilities.

You are responsible for your guest’s actions. You need to know who your guests are and when they are here.

Guest passes can only be issued on a daily basis, no exceptions.

Simply call the Association office anytime in advance of their arrival, and instruct your guests to pick up their guest passes at the Association office.

We will not call a member to verify authorization after a potential guest arrives. If members want to authorize guest use it is their responsibility to follow the procedure in place, and to make sure their guests follow the procedure as well.
